SATIATED - *Spiritual Theme of the Month*

FILLED: I am *filled* with MY life, Spirit and the Universe. I am *filled* because of my thirst for them. When I ignore that “thirst,” I begin filling myself with something else, other than me. The interesting thing is, when I try-too-hard to get things, do things, or have things (or have someone) I will never be truly satisfied. Meaning, I will be caught in a cycle of, ‘The Great Out There’ (living for the outer). Yet, there is no trying to get it or achieve it or even have it . . . I am it; What ever I seek, it is me and I am it. While this can sound ethereal, it is very robust and practical.
