

WHOLESOME - Spiritual Theme of the Month

SOLITARY: I am actually here for a very simple purpose — to grow in consciousness; to evolve spiritually. It is the process of becoming one-with-all. But, there is no one that can raise my state-of-consciousness for me. No one that will evolve me. I can get 'confused,' however, when I think someone is going to 'take-care-of-me.'
